Expression of Interest Invited for Organizing Awareness Programme on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR)

On the occasion of the 75th anniversary of independence, Government of India has launched the National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM) under the banner “Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav” to create widespread awareness on IPR through Intellectual Property Offices, Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade(DPIIT), Govt. of India. Intellectual Property Rights Information Centre – Kerala (IPRIC-K) functioning in KSCSTE, which is the Nodal Agency of the Kerala State for Intellectual Property Rights related matters and services is coordinating the activities under the Mission in the Kerala State for conducting IPR Awareness Programmes for the student community through out the State in association with Patent Office, Chennai. KSCSTE-IPRIC-K invites expression of interest in the form of proposal for the activity.

The Expression of interest is invited from the Higher Secondary Schools/Polytechnic Colleges/Science Colleges and Engineering Colleges. For the participation in this awareness programme only one proposal will be accepted from a single institution. The programme will be conducted in online and offline mode which will be decided later. The minimum number of participants required for offline seminar will be 100 and more than 200 for the online. The programme will be conducted free-of-cost and the Resource Person will be arranged from the Patent Office. The duration of the programme will be about 75 minutes. Certificates will be issued by the Govt. of India to all the participants. The Institutions involved in this National Mission will be awarded Letter of Appreciation for the active participation in the implementation of the programme.
